Kyla studies the flute with Jonathan Rimmer in Manchester and Clare Southworth in London. She is a member of the National Youth Wind Orchestra of Great Britain, and principal flute in the Derbyshire County Youth Orchestra and Wind Band. Her wind quintet, Bella Cinque, recently performed in the Adrian Boult Hall in Birmingham as part of the National Festival of Music for Youth and they have been featured on BBC Radio Derby. Kyla has taken part in many master-classes with some of the county's leading musicians and earlier this year was given the rare opportunity to observe rehearsals at the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra. Kyla is using her gap year to further her flute playing but has also undertaken a fashion illustration course at the London College of Fashion. From September she will be studying music at King's College, London whilst receiving her flute tuition at the Royal Academy of Music.
